**Evidence of Mandatory Vaccination Checklist  
for Applicants, Student Police Officers and Probationary Constables  
(recruited or employed on or after 1 November 2024)**

The listed vaccinations and demonstrating immunity to these communicable diseases is mandatory. Acceptable evidence of protection against specified infectious includes:

- Record of vaccinations/immunisations as signed by a registered medical practitioner; and/or
- Australian Immunisation Record sourced directly from Medicare or MyHealthRecord; and/or
- Serological confirmation (that is, blood test) confirming sufficient protection/immunity; and/or
- Other acceptable evidence as detailed in the table below.

**The assessing clinician must attach or upload the relevant medical evidence with this checklist.**

Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (dTPa)	1 dose of a dTpa vaccine (not ADT vaccine) from within the last 10 years	Nil	Nil	
Hepatitis B*	3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine (typically with minimum intervals of 0, 1, 4 or 0, 2, 4 months apart) (if received vaccines as adolescent between 11-15 years old, may only require 2 doses 4-6 months apart)	<b>AND</b> Hepatitis B surface antibody $\geq 10$ mIU/ml OR Hepatitis B core or surface antibody positive (if has Hepatitis B infection, ensure adequately treated; refer to Section 3.11.3 of the Medical Standards)	Nil	
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	2 doses of MMR vaccine at least 1 month apart	<b>OR</b> Positive IgG serology for measles, mumps and rubella	<b>OR</b> Birth date before 1966 does not require evidence of vaccine or serology testing	
Varicella	$\geq 14$ years old: 2 doses of varicella vaccine (at least 4 weeks apart); or, <b>OR</b> <14 years old: 1 dose of varicella vaccine	Positive IgG serology for Varicella	Nil	

\*Non-responders to Hepatitis B vaccine: Recommended to receive further doses and serological testing as per the [Australian Immunisation Handbook](#).  
\*Non-responders that fail to develop immunity despite further multiple doses of Hepatitis B vaccine may be exempted from demonstrating immunity to Hepatitis B, provided completion of a declaration and undertaking agreement.
